

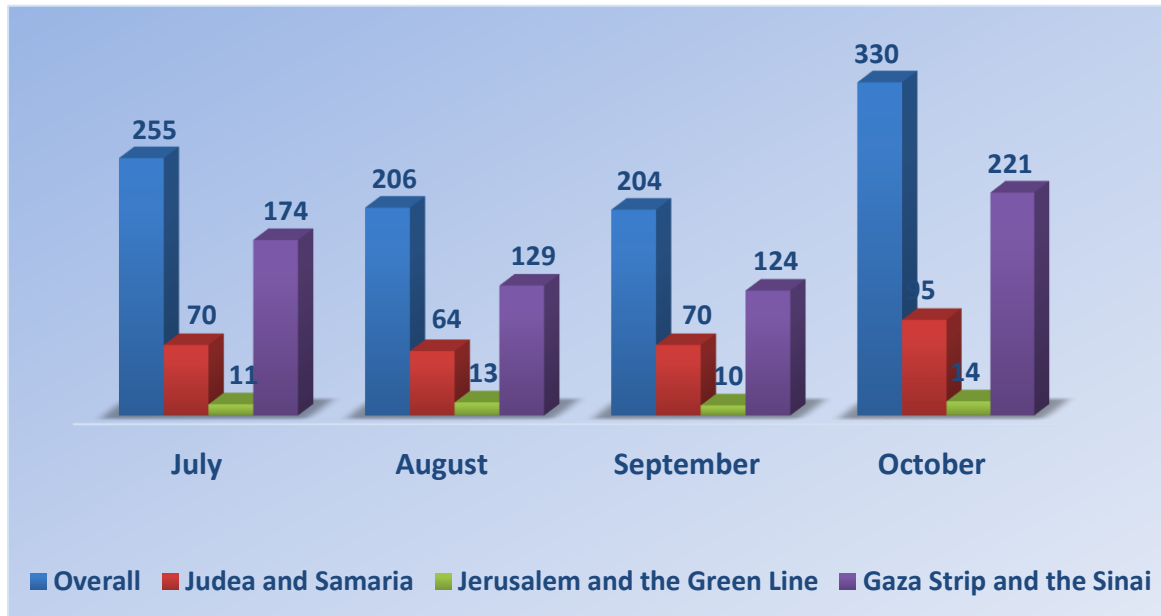
Monthly Summary – October 2018

October 2018 saw **a significant rise in the number of terrorist attacks: 330** (including 221 firebomb attacks), compared to 204 in September 2018.

In Judea and Samaria, 95 attacks were executed in October, compared to September's 70. **14 attacks** took place in **Jerusalem**, as opposed to 10 in the preceding month. **No attacks** were executed **within the Green Line** in October, similarly to September. Finally, **221 attacks originated from the Gaza Strip and the Sinai Peninsula** in October (including 141 firebomb attacks), up from 124 in September.

Two civilians were killed and one was moderately injured in a shooting at the Barkan Industrial Park in Samaria on 7 October. **One member of the security forces was moderately injured and one civilian was slightly injured** in a stabbing in Samaria on 11 October.

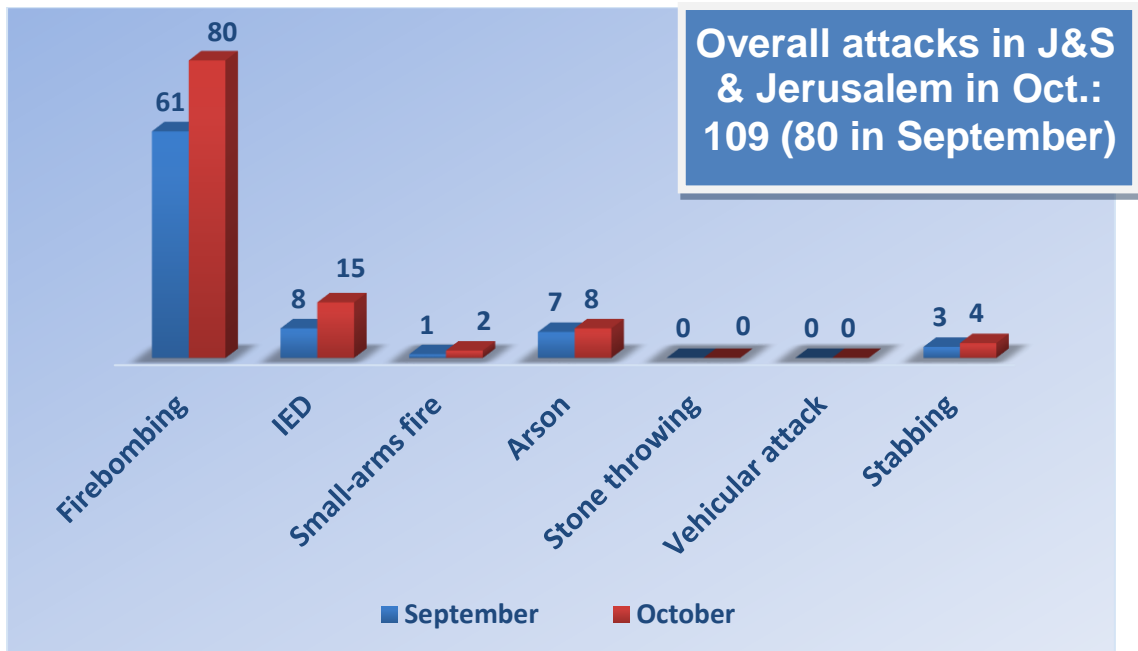
Distribution of Attacks in October 2018,
Compared to Preceding Months:



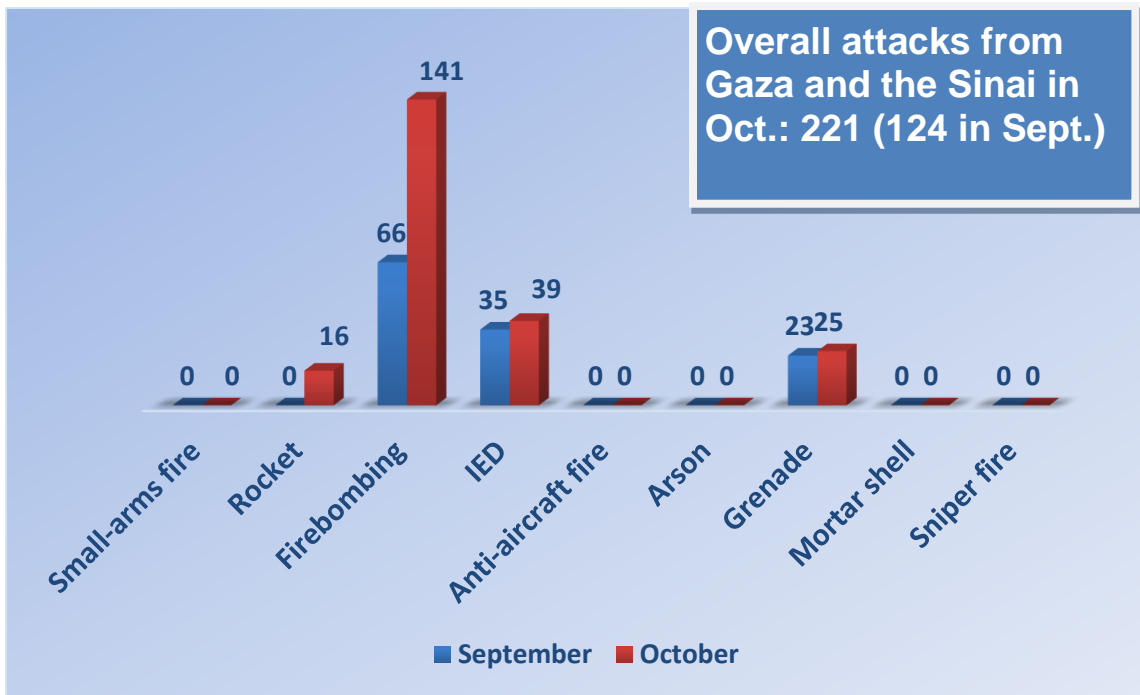
Distribution of Terrorist Attacks in October 2018
by Region and Type of Attack

In Jerusalem and J&S – 109 attacks: 15 IEDs (including gas tanks and pipe bombs); 80 firebombings; four stabbings; two shootings; and eight arsons.

In October 2018, 16 rocket-launching* attacks (with 46 launches) were directed from the Gaza Strip at Israel. No such attacks had taken place in September.

**Clarification: The number of launchings is the number of rockets/mortar shells actually launched during one high-trajectory fire attack. For example: one attack may consist of three launches, that is, three rockets / mortar shells, and so it will be counted as one attack and three launches.*
